TO THE COMMAND OF THE 28th DIVISION
TO THE COMMAND OF THE 282nd IBlbr

Pursuant to the order by the 28th Division Kov⁵, strictly confidential No.01-67/95, dated 1 June 1995, about raising the state of b/g⁶ to the highest level, and the order to carry out certain combat tasks on L/O of the territorial units, as well as in zones of UN forces' observation points within Z/O⁷ of the 282nd IBlbr.

I hereby s u b m i t the following:

R E P O R T

Through 5, 6, 7, and 8 June 1995 I was on Jovino brdo [sic] line and established the following state: there are 23 soldiers from the 2nd LPC⁸, two (2) soldiers are AWOL⁹, specifically Bekto Krdžić and Sedin Salkić from the 282nd IBlbr, and [there are] 15 mujahedeen soldiers from the 283rd IBlbr brigade. The soldiers are 100% armed. There is IDV¹⁰ and it is operating in accordance with the plan. On 6 June 1995, with an IDV squad, I reconnoitred the terrain from tt¹¹ 936 to tt 1071 between 05 and 17 hours. At tt 1071 we noticed that the Chetniks¹² occasionally came [there].

On 7 June 1995, with an IDV squad, I reconnoitred the terrain at tt 974 between 06 and 15 hours and did not notice anything particular.

On L/O of the 2nd LPC, tt 936, the operating is going in accordance with the plan and programme, [and] Ševal Hasanović, Deputy Commander of Company, and Ramiz Krdžić, Commander of Platoon, both from the 2nd LPC are on the line. The weapons on the line are dirty and unclean, of which I

warned the Deputy Commander of the Company and gave him a specific deadline by when all weapons on the line should be cleaned and oiled. There are no paramedics on the line. As for the cooks, the soldiers are not complaining about the food, and I saw for myself that the food is prepared well.

The communication is operating and is in proper condition, and the communications operator was professionally trained.

I hereby request:

- the Commandant of the Brigade to take measures against the soldiers from the 2nd LPČ who were not on duty, and to issue an order to designate a unit for organising the line at tt 936;
- the Assistant Commandant for Logistics to provide all MTS¹³ necessary for organising the line;
- I shall hold Chief of Engineering responsible for organising the line;
- the Chief of Medical Service to provide paramedics that would constantly be on the lines one at a time.
