I congratulate you on the successfully carried out combat operations with which you significantly contributed to carrying out a more successful operation to lift the Sarajevo blockade and inflicted heavy losses on the a/s⁴ in the struggle for the final liberation of the RBiH⁵ and the defeat of Serbian and Montenegrin fascism.

In the coming period, comply with the orders issued so far.
 Prepare plans for active combat operations at the given time.
 You shall receive an order for the coming b/ds from us or the GŠ⁶ of the ARBiH⁷.

Because there have been problems with convoys entering Žepa and Srebrenica, at this moment it is important to have carefully worked out plans for b/ds, but also to wait for a more favourable moment (because of the difficult situation with supplying food for the citizens and members of the ARBiH and the MUP⁸) for further attack b/ds outside the zones of Srebrenica and Žepa.

Take all measures to prevent [people] from leaving the areas of Srebrenica and Žepa, which is one of the most important tasks for you at this moment, if not even the most important one.

Heavy a/s control the roads to Caparde and Kladanj (you have received information about that).

I congratulate you once again on successfully carried out b/ds, especially the Command of the 285th lbr.

Send a report on b/ds that you carried out.
