1. a) Enemy deployed in established locations is strengthening the line in z/o¹, and carrying out provocations on a daily basis. Due to the activities of our diversionary groups, as well as increased activity of the enemy, shelling by the enemy is becoming more frequent.

b) We have no data on the activities of the enemy intelligence services via international organisations for the previous period.

c) Counterpropaganda and subversive activity is directed at the population of the enclave, during which the enemy carries out the stopping of convoy, as well as taking down the rare items which rarely arrive.

2. a) In the previous period, there were no organising of exchanges nor meetings with the aggressor party.

b) Cooperation with MUP² bodies is significantly increasing.

3. a) In the previous period, 4 soldiers from the 280th IBLB³ have defected and headed towards Serbia.

b) Leak of secret military information could happen via soldiers that defected in case they should fall into their hands.

c) In the previous period, one criminal charge was submitted against Huso Salihović, Assistant Commandant of the 283th IBLB, and Fahrudin Alić, Assistant Commandant of the Command Post, for committed actions specified in Article 224 paragraph 1 of the KZ⁴ taken over from SFRJ⁵, and in paragraph 3 of the Republic Code.

d) There were two interventions of VP⁶ on the order of PK⁷ OG⁸ (taking of Motorola ham radio device).

e) Cooperation with the command bodies and the work of the commands is satisfactory.

f) On 15 November 1994, soldier Alija Halilović, squad commander in Kriva Kaldrma region, after arbitrarily leaving the demarcation zone, stepped on a land mine on which occasion he lost his leg.

g) On 14 November 1994, diversionary scouting group of the 281st IBLB liquidated 3 enemy soldiers, wounded one, and knows nothing of one, and also confiscated 3 rifles and an insignificant amount of ammunition.
